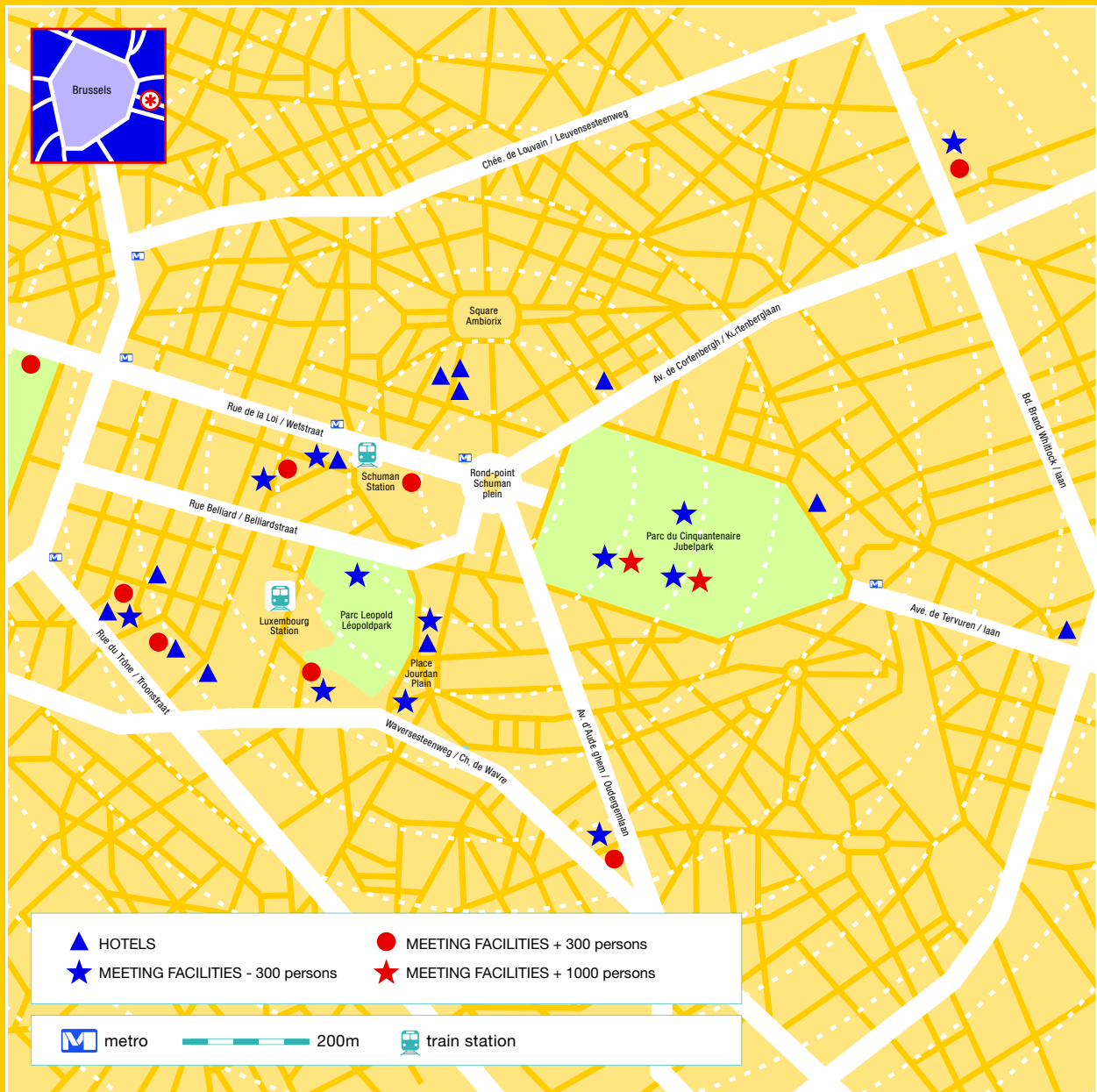




Europe

Small and medium size meetings. This is an exceptional location if you need to link up with the European institutions.

- * **LOCATION:** somewhat remote from the city centre (2km) along the metro line linking downtown and the historical Cinquantaire museums and park.
- * **ENVIRONMENT:** you're right amongst the institutional buildings and 27 EU nationalities. This is an eclectic quarter where functional buildings are mixed with Art Nouveau; where cosmopolitan terraces alternate with busy traffic and crowds.
- * **CONNECTIONS:** direct bus line to Brussels Airport and direct exit to motorways.

- Particularly suitable for visitors who attend various intra- and extra-murals and reconvene for plenary sessions and receptions
- Attractive reception/exhibition facility at Autoworld (1800 m²)
- 6 meeting/exhibition rooms (300m²-1000 m²)
- 35 meeting/breakout rooms (up to 300 persons)
- 1100+ hotel rooms (3* to 5*)

EASY CONNECTIONS

- City centre 5' by metro
- Airport: 15' by taxi or 25' in shuttle bus
- Luxembourg train station in middle of district
- Shopping in fashionable Rue de Tongres/Tongerenstraat:1km
- Short walk to Royal Museums and the impressive Cinquanteenaire Park
