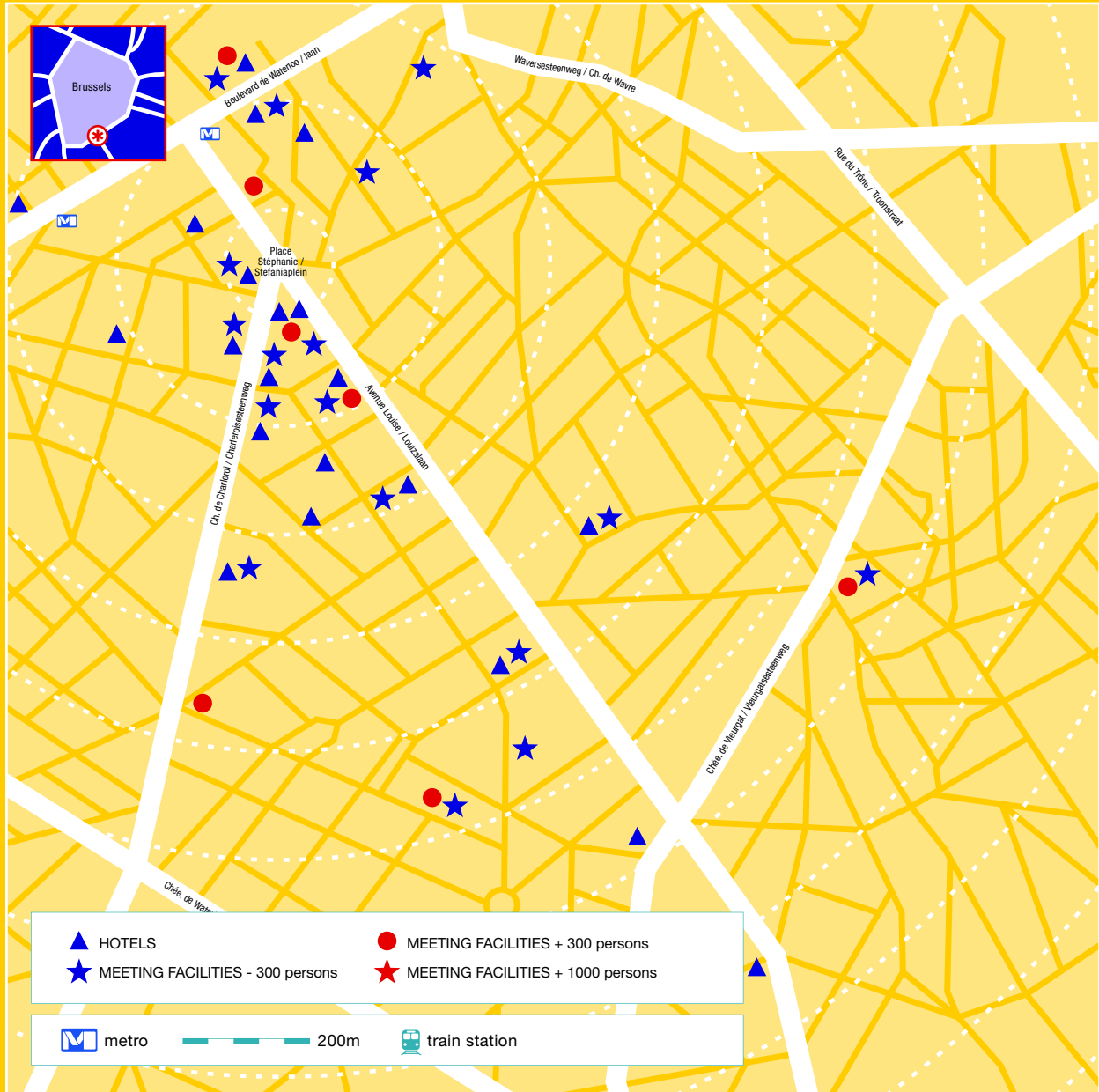




## Louise

If your project is a medium-sized and high-standard meeting, Louise is probably the right solution. Five-star hotels are used to accommodating multi-centre meetings and hosting demanding participants. Also shuttles are easily organized to reach fully-integrated conference facilities, which are slightly decentralized (<1 km).

- \* **LOCATION:** at the south-east edge of the Brussels pentagon. Activities and facilities are essentially spread along the Avenue Louise and Avenue de la Toison d'Or. Short (5 or 10') tram or metro ride to downtown, the Brussels South railway station or the green Bois de la Cambre.
- \* **ENVIRONMENT:** chic avenues with smart, fashionable shops and elegant hotels.
- \* **CONNECTIONS:** rail airport express at South station (5' metro ride).
- \* **LARGER PLENARY CONVENTION ROOMS** at MCE (Management Centre Europe) and Flagey (> 1 km).

- Central location, 1 km from city centre

- South train station 5' on tram
